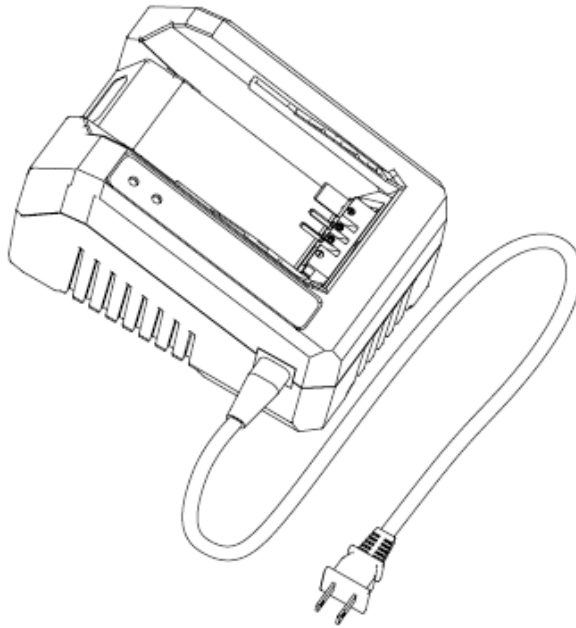

RULES FOR SAFE OPERATION

- **DO NOT OPERATE CHARGER WITH A DAMAGED CORD OR PLUG.** If damaged, call our customer service help line at 1-800-313-5111 for assistance.
- Do not operate charger if it has received a sharp blow, been dropped, or otherwise damaged in any way; call our customer service help line at 1-800-313-5111 for assistance.
- Do not disassemble charger; when service or repair is required call our customer service help line at 1-800-313-5111 for assistance. Risk of electric shock or fire may result if reassembled incorrectly.
- To reduce risk of electric shock, unplug charger from outlet before attempting any maintenance or cleaning. Turning off controls will not reduce this risk.
- Do not use charger outdoors.
- Disconnect charger from power supply when not in use.

PRECAUTIONS REGARDING THE USE OF CHARGER AND BATTERY

- Do not charge battery when temperature is below 32°F (0°C) or above 100°F (38°C).
- Never attempt to connect two chargers together.
- The charger is designed to operate on standard household electrical power. Do not attempt to use it on any other voltage.
- Do not insert foreign matter into the hole for the battery in charger.

- Do not charge by means of an engine generator or DC power source.
- Do not disassemble the battery.
- Do not store the tool and battery in locations where the temperature may reach or exceed 104°F (40°C) such as outside sheds or metal buildings in summer.
- Do not incinerate the battery, even if it is severely damaged or completely worn out. The battery may explode in fire.
- Under extreme usage or temperature conditions, battery leakage may occur. If liquid comes in contact with your skin, wash immediately with soap and water, then neutralize with lemon juice or vinegar. If liquid gets in your eyes, flush them with clean water for at least 10 minutes, then seek immediate medical attention.
- Do not short-circuit the battery.
- Do not discharge battery beyond normal use limits. Further discharging (such as by placing a rubber band on the trigger switch) can cause a deep discharge which may result in polarity reversal of a cell rendering the battery useless.

OPERATION

USE THIS BATTERY CHARGER ONLY WITH EARTHWISE™ 58V LITHIUM-ION BATTERY PACKS. CHARGING BATTERY PACK

Battery packs are shipped in a low charge condition to prevent possible problems. Therefore, you should charge them prior to use.

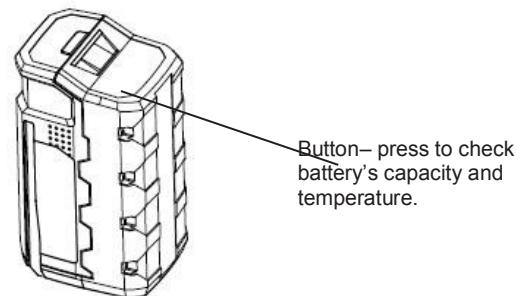
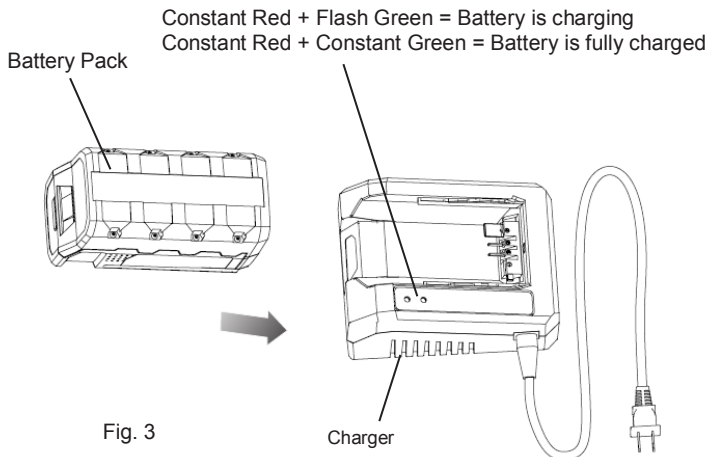
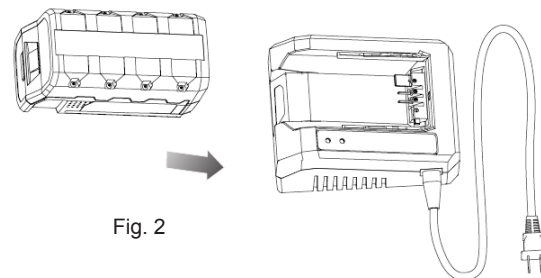
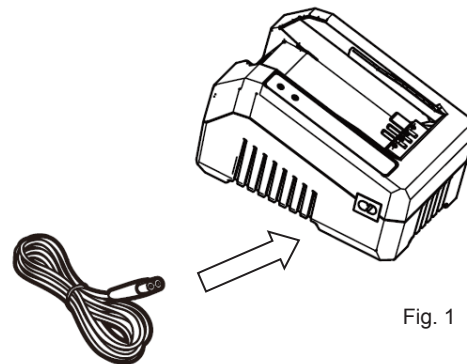
NOTE: Batteries will not reach full charge the first time they are charged. Allow several cycles (operating tool followed by recharging batteries) for them to fully charge.

TO CHARGE

- Use this battery charger only with Earthwise™ Lithium 58V lithium-ion battery packs.
- Make sure power supply is normal house voltage, 120 volts, 60 Hz, AC only.
- Connect the power cord as shown in Fig. 1. Use only the cord provided. Other cord may not fit properly causing unsafe situation.
- Connect charger to power supply. The light will be **constant red** indicating that the power is on.
- Slide battery pack into charger. (Fig. 2)
- Press down on battery pack to be sure contacts on battery pack engage properly with charger contacts.
- Charger lights will be illuminated. (Fig. 3)
A constant **RED** light and a flashing green light indicates the battery is charging.
Constant **RED AND GREEN** lights indicate the battery is fully charged.
- The battery pack will become slightly warm to the touch while charging. This is normal and does not indicate a problem.

- **DO NOT** place charger in an area of extreme heat or cold. It will work best at normal room temperature.
- When the battery is fully charged, unplug your charger from power supply and remove the battery pack.
- Charge time is dependent upon the type of battery pack.

BL85820 charges in approximately 60 minutes.
BL85840 charges in approximately 120 minutes.

LED FUNCTION OF BATTERY PACK:

The battery is equipped with a digital display which shows the battery capacity up to 99% and the battery temperature (Celsius). (Fig.4)

- To check battery capacity, press the LED button once. To check battery temperature, press LED button twice. The lights will automatically shut off after 3 to 5 seconds.
- Battery capacity reading will show a maximum of 99% on the screen.
- When battery pack reaches 70°C , the built in thermal protection will stop the unit to protect the battery from damage. Remove the battery pack from the unit and allow it to cool to below 50°C . Once the battery has cooled, you may reinsert the battery and resume the job.
- During charging, if battery temperature reaches 50°C , the thermal protection will be activated and charging will be halted. When battery cools to less than 45°C, charging will resume. It is advisable to remove the battery from the charger and allow ample time for cooling so the battery can be fully charged without interruption.
- If battery temperature is below 0°C , battery cannot be charged. Charging will begin when battery warms to over 5°C .

OPERATION

Charging a Hot Battery Pack

When using a tool continuously, the battery pack may become hot. A hot battery pack may be placed directly onto the charger port but charging will not begin until the battery temperature cools to within acceptable temperature range. When a hot battery pack is placed on the charger, the red and green LED lights will be flashing alternatively. When the battery pack cools, the charger will automatically begin charging. It is advisable to remove the battery from the charger and allow ample time for cooling so the battery can be fully charged without interruption.


Charging a Cold Battery Pack

A cold battery pack may be placed directly onto the charger port but charging will not begin until the battery temperature warms to within acceptable temperature range. When a cold battery pack is placed on the charger, the red LED and green LED will be flashing. When the battery pack warms, the charger will automatically begin charging.

After the battery has been fully charged, the LED lights will remain on until the charger is disconnected from the power source. Output current from the charger stops an hour after the battery is fully charged.

WARRANTY POLICY

Five (5) year limited warranty on Earthwise 58 volt outdoor power equipment and two (2) year limited warranty on Earthwise 58 volt battery packs and chargers.

Earthwise warrants to the original owner that each new product and service part is free from defects in materials and workmanship and agrees to repair or replace any defective product or part for the warranty period as stated above from the original date of purchase except for the conditions and circumstances listed below:

This warranty applies only to the original purchaser at retail and may not be transferred.

Warranty applies if the product is used for personal, household or family use. Warranty is void if product is used for commercial, industrial or rental purposes.

Warranty does not include repairs necessary due to operator's abuse or negligence (including overloading the product beyond capacity or immersion in water), or the failure to assemble, operate, maintain or store the product according to the instructions in the operator's manual.

This warranty is not transferable and only applies to product sold directly from an authorized retailer. This warranty does not apply to any product, new or used, purchased through unauthorized third-party channels.

ANY INCIDENTAL, INDIRECT OR CONSEQUENTIAL LOSS, DAMAGE, OR EXPENSE THAT MAY RESULT FROM ANY DEFECT, FAILURE OR MALFUNCTION OF THE PRODUCT IS NOT COVERED BY THE WARRANTY.
